Professional achievements and relevant experience:

Steven joined Acanthus Clews Architects in 1990. He became a Company Director in 1999. During his time at Acanthus Clews Architects Steven has focused on buildings for living, and he heads the specialist residential team within the Practice.

Through his understanding of architectural language and his sensitive approach to design Steven has created a series of exemplar residential projects at Acanthus Clews Architects. These include the restoration and extension of the grade II* listed Dinton Hall to create a stunning new home, the restoration of a Georgian model farm complex and the refurbishment and modernisation of the historic farmhouse at Charlock Farm, the sensitive alteration and repair of the outbuildings at Dean Farm to create a superb new house with ancillary accommodation and at Paradise Farm, the design for a new house and equestrian centre incorporating a sustainable design approach on a sensitive and challenging site.

Steven has extensive experience of housing development in both rural and urban settings. He is skilled at analysing complex sites and developing a strategic approach to maximising the potential of a site; projects include the development at Upper Wraxall, to provide new and converted residential accommodation and Home Farm, Wardington, to provide new and converted dwellings within the setting of the historic farmhouse. Steven is responsible for the residential-led urban regeneration of Britannia Works in Atherstone, combining the re-use of listed redundant industrial buildings within the town centre to provide quality new residential and mixed-use accommodation.

As well as his work in the residential sector, Steven has been the design lead on a variety of community and healthcare projects including the extensive reordering and the extension of the Wardington House Nursing Home. Steven is also the Director responsible for Human Resources and the Company Secretary.
